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**Invitation to Bid Rodeo Stock
for the 2017 Senior National Finals Rodeo at
Panguitch, UT
October 3 – 7, 2017**

Contractor and its designated sub-contractors (if any) will deliver stock to Panguitch, UT no later than the afternoon of October 2, 2017.

Calves must be high quality, preconditioned, of the same breed and cross breeds should be of the same cross, with weights between 180 and 250 pounds. The number of calves must be equal to the number of contestants if there are 11 or fewer contestants in the event (plus extras). If there are 12 or more contestants, half enough (plus extras) is acceptable (bid can be based on the number entered in the 2015 SNFR). We suggest no less than 3 extras in each age division and event. Calves are to be identified by a separate colored and number ear tag. Any deviation from this must be approved by the Calf Roping/Ribbon Roping/Breakaway Director or his designee.

Steers are to be identified by a separate colored and number ear tag. Dogging steers must weigh a minimum of 450 and a maximum of 650 pounds. The maximum weight for the team roping steers is 700 pounds/head. Any deviation from this must be approved by the Director or his designee.

Bucking stock must be numbered legibly before drawing. All animals should be screened and agreed on before they are put in the draw. We will be looking at the number of entries compared to what the bid numbers are. Example if there is only 2 BR and the bid covers 6 BR we will be looking to adjust that bid. If there is an adjustment warranted it will be decided 2 business days after entries close.

Suggested weight limits for Calf roping:

68's-180 to 200
60's-180 to 200
50's-180 to 200
40's- 200 to 220

Suggested weight limits for Ribbon Roping:

60's- 180 to 210
50's- 180 to 220
40's- 200 to 240

Suggested weight limits for Breakaway:

220 to 250

Contestant numbers will be provided to contractor by the National Office staff following the close of entries.

The National Senior Pro Rodeo Association will be responsible for supplying prepared ground, holding pens, and injured animal conveyance. The NSPRA will not supply grain and hay. The NSPRA shall not be responsible for any stock that may become crippled or die while in use at the Senior National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas, Nevada. Security will be provided by NSPRA volunteers. Contractor is responsible for health and brand inspection papers, delivery, feeding, doctoring and pickup of stock. Suitability of all animals will be determined by the event director, or his designee. Failure to provide the required numbers and quality of stock shall result in a fine levied against the stock contractor (fine to be a

minimum of \$25.00 per run or be determined the Board of Directors). NSPRA will not be responsible for any animals that upon delivery are lame, sick or otherwise unhealthy.
